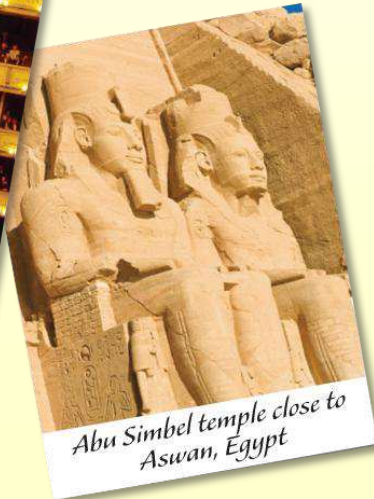
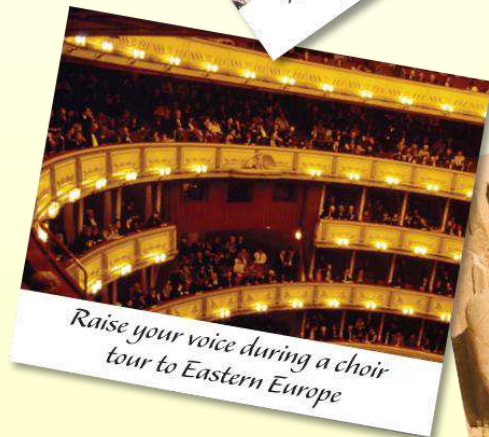
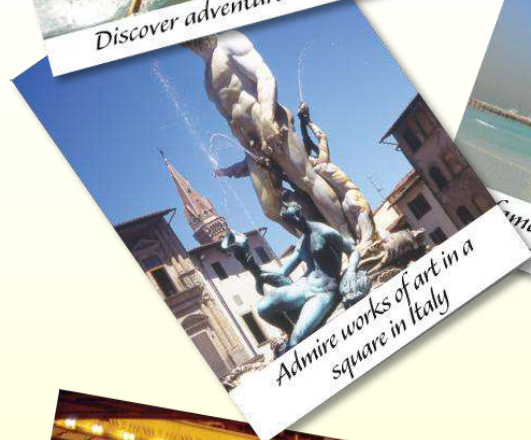
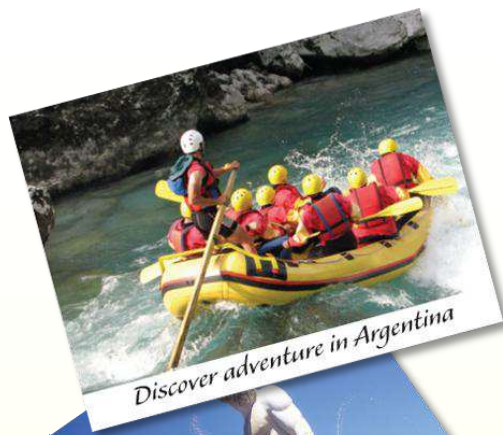
Who is Travel & Sport?

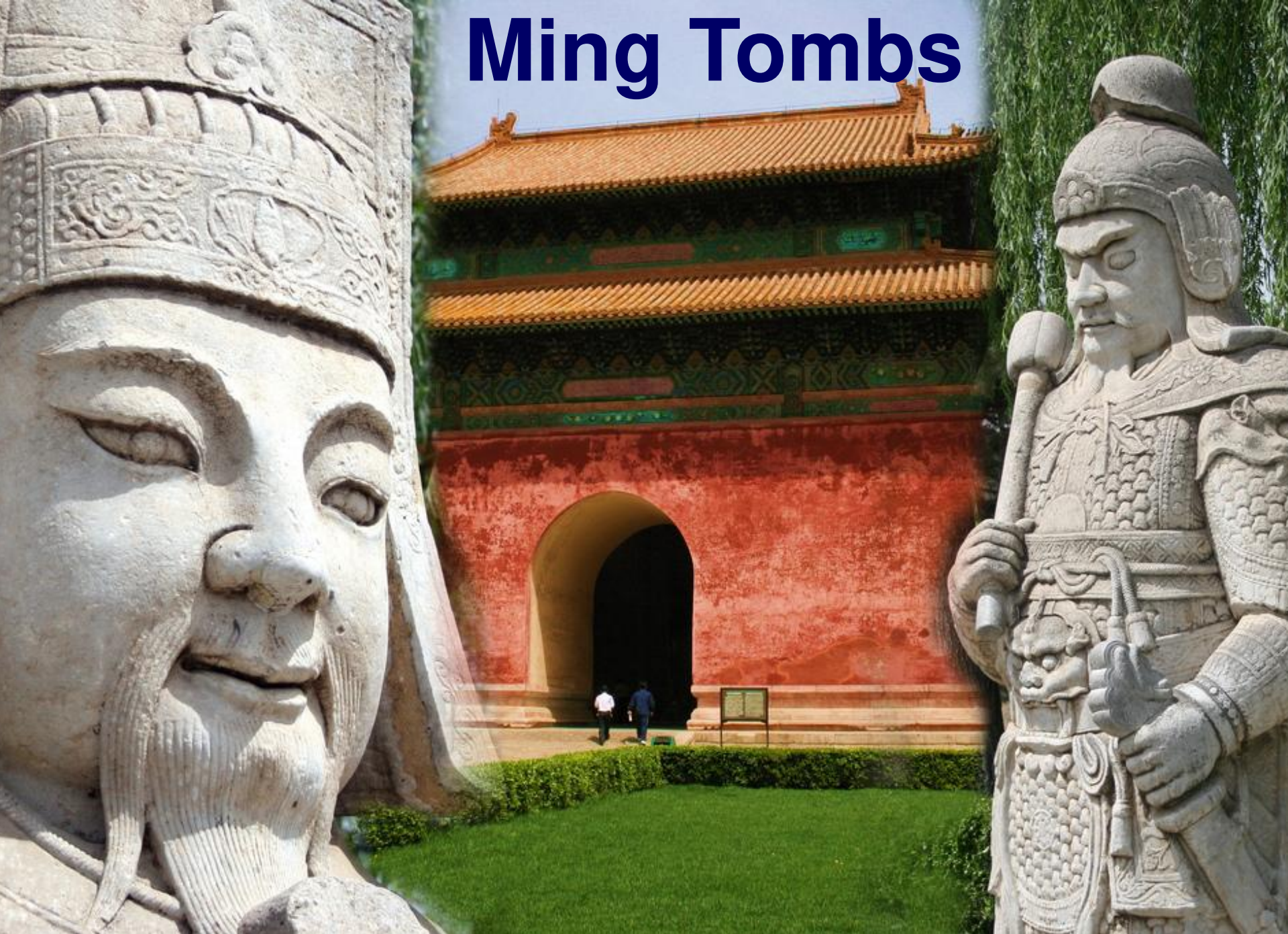

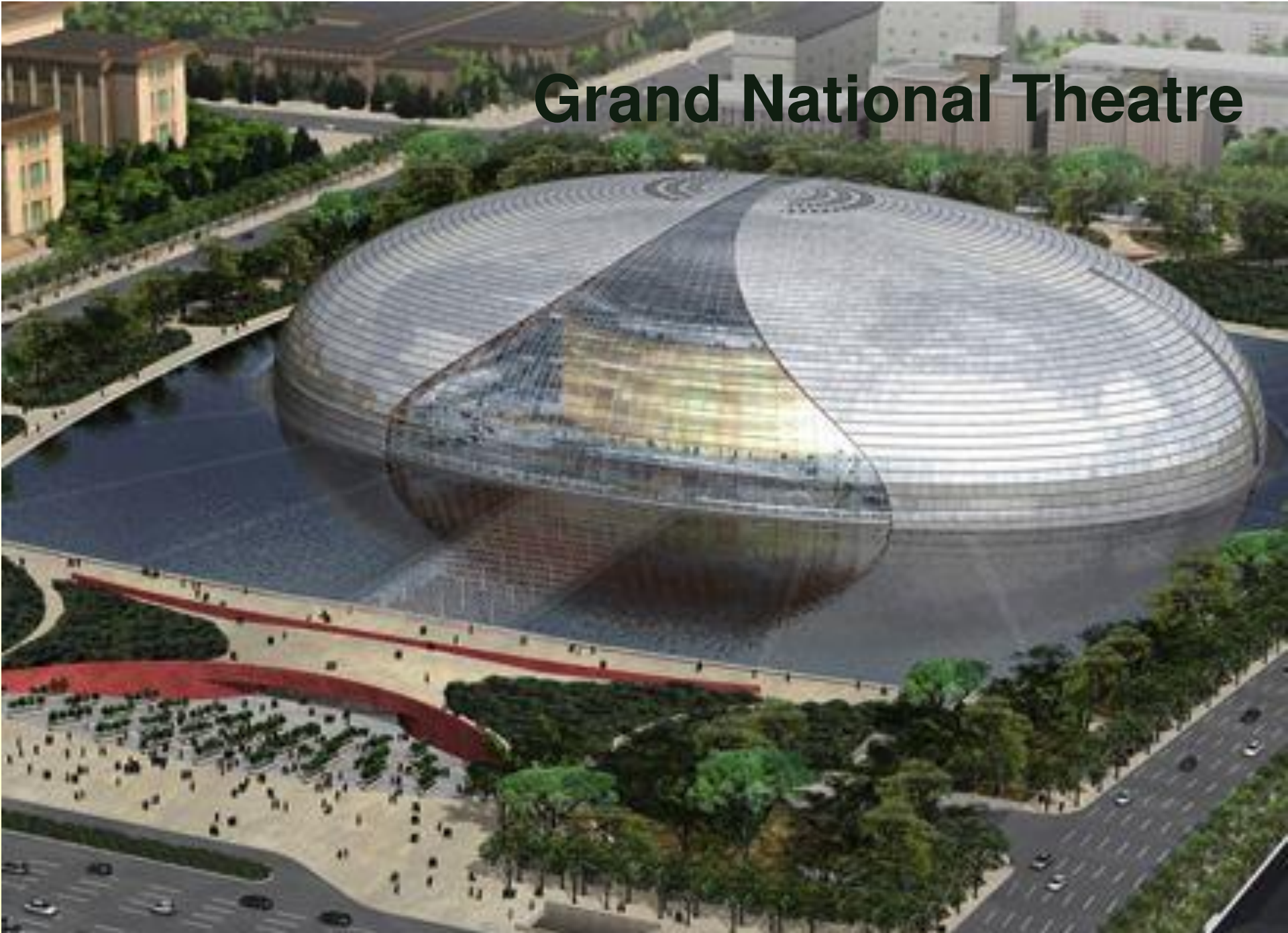
